King of Jerusalem

Jehoshaphat King of Jerusalem appointed Worship singers to walk in front before the battle! Enemies were the Moabites & Amorites. [1 Kings22, 2 Chron 20]

Psalm 92:1

It is good to give thanks to the Lord, And to sing praises to Your name, O Most High; ² To declare Your lovingkindness in the morning, And Your faithfulness every night, ¹²

The righteous [Know who your Father is] shall flourish [Groei, vrug dra, beskerming, voorsiening] like a palm tree, He shall grow like a cedar [Krag, eerbaarheid, perfeksie] in Lebanon.

¹³ Those who are PLANTED [Vestig in God, getrouheid, Sy Huis, Sy Woord] in the house of the Lord SHALL FLOURISH [Lewe, oorwinning, guns] in the courts of our God.

¹⁴ They shall still bear fruit in old age; They shall be fresh and flourishing, [Even when they LOOK old] ¹⁵ To declare that the Lord is upright; He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him. Psalm 122: ¹ I was glad when they said unto me, let us go into the house of the Lord.

Trees are PLANTED

Psalm 1:³

Trees are planted, otherwise, they will not bear any fruit!

Therefore, God wants us not to be like Potted Plants [No Strong Roots]! Palm Tree & Cedar Tree. Two of the STRONGEST and GREATEST trees that exist!
